Sat. Nov 5 2011	<u>Manganinnie</u> (1980))/NFSA	<u>Manganinnie</u> journeys in search of her vanished tribe. The story of the Black Drive of 1830, the near-genocide of the Tasmanian Aborigines. With special guests John Honey, the director and, hopefully, members of the Tasmanian Aboriginal Community. RATED G
Sat Nov 19 2011	GERMAN FILM FESTIVAL	Family/Children's film " <u>Das Fliegende Klassenzimmer</u> " = The Flying Classroom (1954) @ 5pm, German dinner at about 6:30, Main Feature " <u>Himmel über Berlin</u> " = Wings of Desire (1987) at about 8pm – proceeds towards Hall kitchen renovations. More details closer to the date
Sat 3 Dec 2011	<u>Saturday Night Fever</u> (1977)/Roadshow	Special "70's disco night" – more details closer to the date. RATED MA
Sat 17 Dec 2011	<u>A Christmas Story</u> (1983)/NFSA	<u>Ralphie</u> has to convince his parents, teachers, and Santa that a Red Ryder BB gun really is the perfect gift for the 1940's. RATED G
Sat Jan 21 2012	<u>Babe</u> (1995)/Roadshow	<u>Babe</u> , a pig raised by sheepdogs, learns to herd sheep with a little help from Farmer <u>Hoggett</u> . RATED G
Sat Feb 4 2012	<u>Blithe Spirit</u> (1945)	Adapted from a play by Noel Coward, Charles and his second wife Ruth, are haunted by the ghost of his first wife, Elvira. Medium Madame <u>Arcati</u> tries to help things out by contacting the ghost. RATED PG
Sat Feb 11 2012	<u>Fiddler on the Roof</u> (1971)/Roadshow	In pre-revolutionary Russia, a poor Jewish peasant must contend with marrying off his three daughters while <u>antisemitic</u> sentiment threatens his home. RATED G
Sat Feb 25 2012	<u>The Red Violin</u> (1998)/Roadshow	A perfect red-colored violin inspires passion, making its way through three centuries over several owners and countries, eventually ending up at an auction where it may find a new owner. With a special violin recital beforehand. RATED M
Sat Mar 10 2012	<u>Under the Tuscan Sun</u> (2003)/Roadshow	While on vacation, a just-divorced writer buys a villa in Tuscany on a whim, hoping it will be the start of a change for the better in her life. RATED M
Sat Mar 24 2012	<u>Amadeus</u> (1984)/Roadshow	The incredible story of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, told in flashback mode by Antonio <u>Salieri</u> - now confined to an insane asylum. RATED PG
Sat Apr 28 2012	<u>Frida</u> (2002)/Roadshow	A biography of artist <u>Frida Kahlo</u> , who channeled the pain of a crippling injury and her tempestuous marriage into her work. RATED MA
Sat May 12 2012	<u>Black Orpheus</u> (1959)/NFSA	A retelling of the Orpheus and Eurydice myth, set during the time of the <u>Carnaval</u> in Rio de Janeiro. (SUBTITLED) RATED PG
Sat May 26 2012	<u>Kitchen Stories</u> (2003)/NFSA	A scientific observer's job of observing an old <u>cantakerous</u> single man's kitchen habits is complicated by his growing friendship with him. (SUBTITLED) RATED PG
Sat June 9 2012	<u>The Bicycle Thieves</u> (1948)/NFSA	A man and his son search for a stolen bicycle vital for his job. One of the key works of Italian neo-realism. (SUBTITLED) RATED PG
Sat July 21 2012	<u>My Dinner with Andre</u> (1981)	Wallace Shawn and Andre Gregory, apparently playing themselves, share their lives over the course of an evening meal at a restaurant. RATED G
Sat Aug 18 2012	<u>Double Indemnity</u> (1944)/NFSA	The tale of a desperate dame and a greedy man. The archetypal film noir. RATED PG
Sat Sept 15 2012	<u>The King's Speech</u> (2010) /Roadshow	The story of King George VI of Britain, his impromptu ascension to the throne and the speech therapist who helped the unsure monarch become worthy of it. RATED M
